Dear People of God at Grace,

After 13-plus months of transition at Grace, the Ministry Site Profile will soon be complete. Your Council and Transition Team have been doing a lot of work and preparation for calling a new pastor. Their faithfulness to the task of leadership during the pandemic and transition time has revealed their faith and trust in God's promise to lead through this time.

Let me tell you about the communal discernment with Luther House led by Pr Melissa Reed, our Oregon Synod Bishop's Associate.

Our first combined meeting was in early July in Ronnenkamp Hall. The focus of that gathering was to share stories about the two ministries—Luther House and Grace—in order to see how God has been at work, to understand how this point in time has yielded transition in both places and begin to listen and ask questions together.

The August meeting via Zoom focused on the close proximity and the surrounding neighborhood, including OSU. The discussion included shared values, concern for families, students, and neighbors, and to listen for themes and relationships within the Corvallis community.

In September by Zoom we explored the common horizon before us during this transition time, talking about what we are able to bring to the table of discernment. Is there capacity (resources) and vitality (energy) enough to journey together and be strengthened in ministry.

Our final meeting, which will take place on Saturday, October 30, will focus on what it could look like to walk together into the new horizon, not just a vision, but a horizon that God has led Grace and Luther House to face. The question of what leadership will be needed as these two vital ministries move toward this new horizon, new opportunities, new mission, new ways of being followers of Jesus.

The outcome will most likely not look like the pastoral leadership of previous times. Oh some things might be the same, but this transitional time for both Grace and Luther House is transformational. What will emerge is not easy to predict, and will be shaped by the next called pastor/s and the Holy Spirit, and you and the neighborhood and...this is

exciting and risky and hopeful.

In Matthew 9:10-17 Jesus is asked why he and his disciples don't hold to the traditions and practices of the Pharisees and also those of John the Baptizer's disciples. Jesus responds with: "No one sews a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old cloak, for the patch pulls away from the cloak, and a worse tear is made. Neither is new wine put into old wineskins; otherwise, the skins burst, and the wine is spilled, and the skins are destroyed; but new wine is put into fresh wineskins and so both are preserved."

If old and new are to be preserved, how do we know when to keep what is old and when to choose what is radically new and transformational? Can the old be transformational? There are no easy answers to these questions. It takes discerning together, looking at, listening, pondering, dreaming, and then stepping out in faith that where God leads, both old and new are necessary and needed in different ways for the sake of God's mission in this world.

The new horizon is more than a vision, as the possibilities are myriad. The new horizon before Grace and Luther House comes at a time of massive shifts and changes in our world. How will we move together? What will leadership look like in this changing reality? Who will we minister to? And who will minister to us? And who will join us in this journey toward this new horizon before us?

Always, always, God is with us. The Spirit is moving in us. Jesus is the head of the Church. And we keep moving forward with the love of God to share in whatever old and new ways we are able.




