#### Siblings in Christ,

This past month was full of activities and fellowship grounding us in this walk of faith together. A huge shout out and thank you to the hosts of the food and fellowship events this past month. I really enjoyed these smaller spaces to share stories and get to know you. Coming up is a walk on February 10 rain or shine! I am hopeful that these types of fellowship events will continue in the future, so that we can continue to build community together as we journey in faith.

My installation is on February 18th at 3:30. At this point I will officially be your pastor! While that seems slightly silly to have it so much later, it often takes time to get all of the pieces together for an installation. People from the synod, the pastor to be installed, local clergy, and the congregation are all invited to the event. In this service we make promises to one another for how we will live together in faith. There will be times that we fail one another, and we promise to come to each other for reconciliation and forgiveness. Living in community can be hard and it is filled with so much joy. We were not created to live alone. We were created to live together in community laugh together, mourn together, read the scriptures together, and live faithfully as God's people in this place. This world is too hard to live alone so come and celebrate this transition in our life together.

Lent is around the corner! Ash Wednesday is Valentine's day this year. Growing up my family always sent out valentine's day cards as opposed to Christmas cards, because the end of the year was incredibly busy. A check in to how our family was doing and our hopes for the next year. Lent has often been a time of checking in and a reset for our faith. The practice of giving up or adding a prayer practice is incredibly common as tools to check in with our faith. For Lent our theme will be Love Drives Out Fear. In times of uncertainty and change it is love that often grounds us. Moving with curiosity and love grounds us and helps us avoid reacting or living in fear. We will be exploring God's Love for us, Our Love for Christ, love of neighbor, and more. May this Lent be a time where you love yourself. Give yourself the grace and love you need and love thy neighbor.

# **Courtyard Memorial Project**



The Courtyard Memorial Project is envisioned to be constructed early this year and will be funded with special contributions from individual members and former Grace members. A special escrow account ["Courtyard Memorial Project"] has been set up with the church treasurer to collect this money and give donation credit to each member contributing to the project as a charitable contribution. Mark your check payable to Grace Lutheran Church with the note "Courtyard Memorial Project". We are collecting funds now.

The Courtyard will get a revised layout and a new walking surface that is built with 12-inch square pavers that are rose and grey colored. Many of the rose pavers will be memorial pavers inscribed with the name of a loved one. The project cost is estimated to be \$21,000. The Grace Foundation has graciously agreed to fund \$14,000 as matching funds (2:1) for the \$7,000 to be contributed from individual members. As soon as the goal of \$7,000 has been reached the project can start. The Property Committee will manage the design & construction of the project. They will also manage the inscription of the memorial pavers and the long-term care & maintenance of the pavers.



# Stone Soup of Corvallis Needs Volunteers

Grace has seized the opportunity to prepare dinner for Stone Soup at First Christian Church on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of every month. Three to four volunteers are needed to help. Volunteers would arrive at First Christian at 1:30 pm to prepare the meal which is served at 5:30 pm. A separate group of volunteers, not from Grace, do the setup, prepare the drinks, serve the food and do clean-up. So when we are finished preparing dinner we can choose to leave or to stay and help the other volunteers.

Keith, the kitchen manager will provide the menu for the meal. All the food will be on-site and be ready for us to prepare. All volunteers should get a food handler card which can be obtained through a short on-line course followed by an open book test. The cost (~\$10) would be reimbursed by Stone Soup, if desired. Our first Sunday is unfortunately the same Sunday as Pastor Remy's installation, February 18th. If you or someone you know is interested in volunteering please contact Elaine Franklin or Frank Davis. We will compile a list of those interested and send an email every month with the dates Grace is scheduled. You will be able to email back the dates when you can volunteer. Thank you


