Beloved Siblings in Christ,





Council President's Corner

The Council Retreat this year was held on March 2. One of the outcomes was the formation of four teams of Council members to work each on one of four Council Goals. The following Teams have continued to meet to refine their goals and respective activities. Below is a short summary.

- Goal 1 is to cultivate and expand relationships that will promote growth among the Grace
 Family. This team will encourage and supporting intergenerational activities of learning,
 connecting and caring. They plan to help GYM define the role and position of Youth and Family
 Minister and assist in hiring and welcoming the candidate; help define what ministry success looks
 like; and, help establish and support the Youth and Family Ministry strategy. Team includes Dave
 Lundahl, Angie Gallagher Kinsley, Marshall Hill-Tanquist and Cathy Knock.
- Goal 2 is to evaluate and strengthen partnerships including, but not limited to: non-profits (e.g. Vina Moses, We Care, Stone Soup, etc.); Churchwide, Synod, Cluster Organizations (e.g. Luther House, Lutherwood, Youth Gathering, Faith Lutheran Church in Albany, etc.), and provide for immediate care needs (Ida Fund, relationships with other resources, etc.). This team will also work to establish methods for Horizon Hearing regarding potential ministries in order to plan, advocate, and make a way for things to happen (Climate Change, Gig Work Relief, Land Acknowledgement, Antiracism, etc.). Team includes Frank Davis, Juya Lapham, and Robyn Vega
- Goal 3 will improve communication by making use of and supporting the Grace Website, email, and list-serve groups. This team will provide needed assistance to the committees and teams of GELC in communicating to the congregation and persons outside the congregation. They will also assist in recruiting and making operational changes (as needed) with the goal of involving more congregants in the life of Grace. Team includes Nancy Hemming, Carol Warloe, and Charlotte Chrisman
- Goal 4 will be to increase usage of our space/facilities to internal and external groups by increasing its visibility, desirability and useability; grounded in our mission to serve our neighbors. Some short term activities by this team include
- reviewing COVID policies, encourage the use of our facilities by outside groups, update cost structures and review liability coverage and include damage clause (this clause is in current contracts). Team includes Pastor Remy, Mike Franklin, and Meredith Junge.

We are all excited about the possibilities this year to move forward the ministry at and through Grace. As progress is made against these four goals, I will use this President's Corner to provide updates. AS ALWAYS, YOUR PRAYERS AND COMMENTS ARE WELCOME (541-602-3419).

The construction phase of the Memorial Courtyard Project has been completed. The task remaining is to plant shrubbery and flowers along the perimeter as needed. Thanks for tolerating the inconvenience of keeping the entry Lobby & Fireside Room closed for the three weeks. Thanks for the donations to refurbish the Courtyard. The excess funds contributed will be used for constructing a new belltower. The vacant space for the new bell tower is on the east side where the old one once stood. The plan is to design and construct the new belltower next year. There will be several design concepts presented for the new bell tower ----a roof to keep the structure dry will be in all new design concepts. Extensive wood rot was the reason the old belltower was dismantled and removed.

Grace has been providing sack lunches to community members for many years. Since the shut downs in March 2020, Office Staff has seen a different group of community members and we are handing out less and less.

We know that there are Grace members who want to see this ministry grow, but we can't do it all on our own.

In efforts to reach more community members in need, starting in June, Grace will be partnering with Vina Moses for our Sack Lunch Program. Grace will continue to collect, purchase and pack up lunches, but Grace will now be bringing the majority of them to Vina Moses. Office Staff at Grace will continue to hand out sack lunches as needed.

Starting May 5, we will start collecting donations of the following items to go into our sack lunches. Office staff will evaluate the total items collected and will purchase additional items to fit the needs of the sack lunches. On the 4th Sunday of each month, Grace will host a work party to package up 50 sack lunches to bring to Vina Moses.
